Nunquwarrin Yunti of South Australia was established in the 1960s by the late Gladys Elphick MBE, founder of the Council of Aboriginal Women of South Australia. Together with a group of trailblazing women and men, she helped create one of the first Aboriginal organisations in the country.

Formally incorporated in 1971, Nunquwarrin Yunti has grown and adapted over time, evolving from the Aboriginal Cultural Centre, the Aboriginal Community Centre of South Australia, and the Aboriginal Community Recreation and Health Services Centre of South Australia. Our first health program began through community generosity – supported by donations, government funding, and the commitment of an empathetic and dedicated doctor.

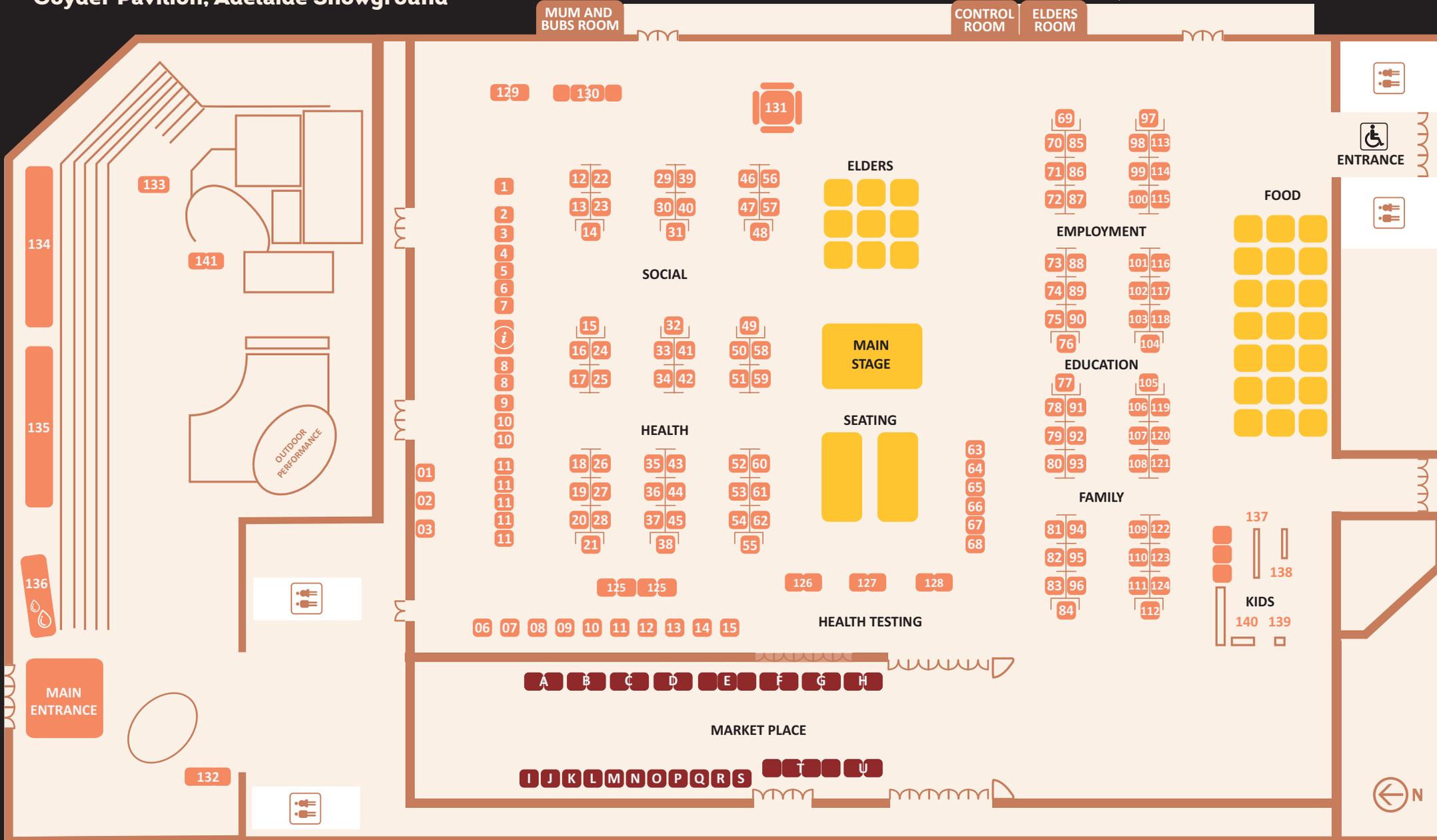
